A free and fully-funded one-year course designed to offer a stepping stone to Cambridge for those who have experienced educational disadvantage.

This course will prepare you for degree courses in the Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences at Cambridge or elsewhere. Progress to one of 18 degree courses at Cambridge including:

- Archaeology
- Education
- English
- History
- Law

And many more...

To be considered for this course, you must have **experienced educational disadvantage or disruption** and because of this, you would not meet Cambridge's usual academic requirements.

This could mean you:

- Have been in care for any length of time
- Have experienced health issues that caused long periods of absence from school
- Attend a school that sends few students to Higher Education
